## NEW TOWNHOME COMMUNITY COMING TO OCEAN CITY, MD

The existing building will be razed and the new 4 unit townhouse community will be built in its place to enhance Ocean City's downtown. Fisher Architecture was originally hired to create a site plan for Ownership to illustrate the possibilities with the blighted apartment building. The team was contracted to keep within the local neighborhood fabric and create new multi-family townhouses. Streetscape renderings were recently presented to Planning and Zoning in the Town of Ocean City and the project was approved. OCDC (Ocean City Development Corporation) has also approved the new community at this time. The new three story, four-unit townhouse project is currently in the Construction Documents phase. Each unit will boast 2 bedrooms, 2 baths, ample living space and private 2 car parking.
